

## **INFORMATION CLAUSE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA REGARDING PANIC 2026 CONFERENCE**

### **Identity of the Administrator**

The Administrator of your personal data is Wrocław University of Science and Technology (Politechnika Wrocławska), registered in Wrocław, Wybrzeże Stanisława Wyspiańskiego 27, 50-370 Wrocław, Poland. You may contact the Administrator via the contact form available at: <https://pwr.edu.pl/en/contact-us>, or in writing at the Administrator's registered address. The Administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO), who can be contacted at: IOD@pwr.edu.pl.

### **Purposes and Legal Basis for Data Processing**

Your personal data is processed for the following purposes:

1. Registration, preparation, organization and execution of the PANIC 2026 Conference, including contacting participants regarding organizational matters and issuing certificates of attendance, based on Article 6(1)(b) GDPR.
2. Communicating with participants to provide information related to the Event and to share information about future editions of the Conference or other scientific events organized by Wrocław University of Science and Technology, based on Article 6(1)(f) GDPR.

### **Recipients of Personal Data**

Your data may be shared only with the entities supporting the organization of the Conference under agreements with Wrocław University of Science and Technology, specifically:

1. entities providing IT services, including participant registration systems;
2. entities providing transportation or accommodation services - only concerning invited speakers if required;
3. hosting or server service providers acting on behalf of the University (e.g., storage of data in University systems).

### **Data Storage Period**

Your personal data will be stored for the time necessary to carry out activities related to organizing and executing the PANIC 2026 Conference, and then up to one year after the Event solely to reissue attendance certificates or provide necessary information regarding participation.

After this period, the data will be permanently deleted or anonymized.

### **Rights of Data Subjects**

You have the right to access your data, rectify them, and request restriction processing, data transfer, object to processing or request erasure, in situations indicated in Articles 15-22 GDPR.

To ensure data security, exercising these rights may require verification of your identity.

**Right to Lodge a Complaint**

You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority responsible for data protection in your country of residence, employment, or the place of the alleged infringement.

In Poland, the supervisory authority is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (PUODO).

**Information on Voluntary or Mandatory Provision of Data**

Providing personal data is necessary for registration and participation in the PANIC 2026 Conference. Failure to provide data makes participation impossible.

The Administrator may contact you using the contact information you provided (including non-university e-mail addresses if given voluntarily) solely for purposes related to organizing the Event or informing you about future editions and related scientific initiatives.
